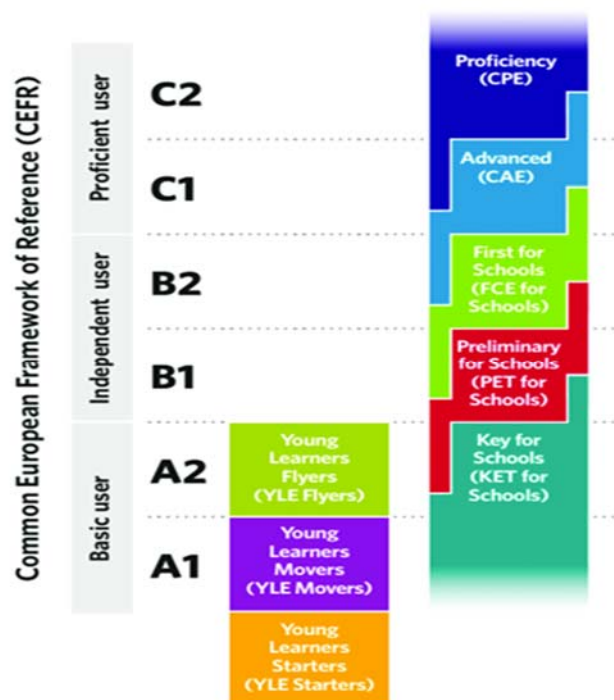


What should you know about ESOL qualification?

What is ESOL?

1. It is a **Cambridge English Qualification**.
2. Cambridge English exams can open doors for you to live, work and study in English-speaking countries and almost anywhere in the world.
3. You may need to apply for a visa before travelling to study or work in another country. As part of your application, you may have to prove your language ability is at a particular level, or your language skills will be taken into account in other ways when your visa application is considered.
4. Cambridge English exams are recognized by over 25,000 universities, employers and governments around the world. You can search for the countries and universities that accept Cambridge English exams using the following link.

Each ESOL exam focuses on a level of the **Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR)**, helping learners to improve their speaking, writing, reading and listening skills step by step. **The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) is an international standard for describing language ability.**

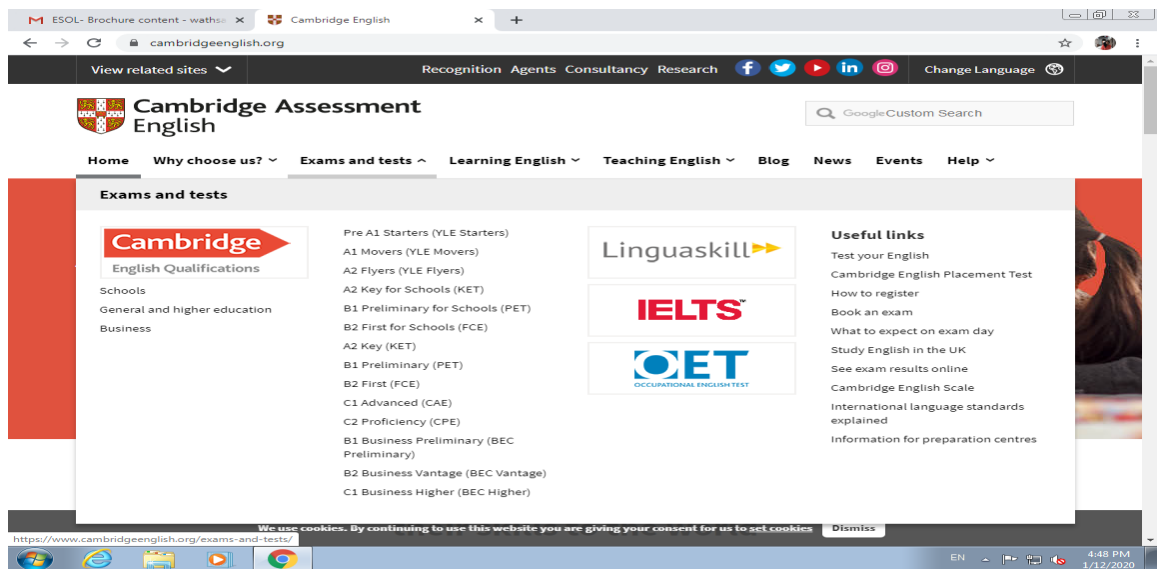


How to help your child at home?
